Eric Fellman joined Bible League International as president in 2011 with the union of Bible League and World Bible Translation Center (WBTC). Fellman was president of the Texas-based WBTC since September 2008. Today, he’s looking forward to seeing how God will expand His kingdom through the combined organization.

An immediate impact of the merger is the expansion of WBTC’s successful literacy program into Bible League’s well-developed global markets. Fellman will also oversee new digital scripture strategies and the development of new products and translations for these markets as he helps lead Bible League’s global field operations.

Before joining WBTC, Fellman was the owner and principal for 11 years of Marketplace Initiatives, a management consulting company focused on publishing and communications. During that same time, he also served as a Senior Associate with the National Prayer Breakfast in Washington, D.C., working especially with international guests.

Fellman was president for three years in the mid-1990s of the Peale Center Division at Guideposts, the largest inspirational publisher in the U.S. He also served on their Board. As author of *The Power Behind Positive Thinking*, Fellman illuminated the spiritual principles of the late Norman Vincent Peale’s message. Early in his career, he was director of public relations for Chicago’s Moody Bible Institute, and editor of *Moody Monthly* magazine.

His broad experience in publishing, development, and public relations, combined with his passion for people to know Jesus Christ, have made him a well-respected leader in Christian circles, and an in-demand speaker.

“The main tool for changing hearts and lives is the Word of God,” says Fellman. “WBTC is dedicated to making easily understandable translations available to the common people everywhere. Bible League International has been ‘called by God to provide Scriptures and training worldwide, so that people prepared by the Holy Spirit will come into fellowship with Christ and His Church.’ Simply stated, **together we’re sharing the story of Jesus through the Bible so that people might believe in Him and find new life.**”

Fellman, a Moody Bible Institute graduate, also holds a Bachelor’s Degree in journalism from the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh and a Master’s in communications from Wheaton College.
